

11. Where category G riders are in the same race as category E&F riders, if at all possible, they should receive fourteen seconds per mile start on category E riders i.e. 7 mins. for a 30 mile race. Where E&F categories are combined with D category they should whenever possible be given a start.

12. Races for categories A, B, C and D should have at least twenty starters in each group. If this number is not attainable, the event organiser should combine groups in order to reach this figure.

13. Except for criteriums, the aim of LVRC promotions is to provide A,B,C and D category riders with a race of two hours duration and categories E,F and G with a race of one hour thirty minutes duration.

PRIZE PRESENTATIONS

14. All prizewinners not attending the prize presentation give up any claim to a prize won, except on the condition that the organiser has been notified beforehand.

FIRST AID AT EVENTS

15. All events must be provided with a qualified first aider and a suitable method of communication with him/her
